The outline of HUSTEP 2018 Spring Semester Course is as follows:

1. Period of Enrollment: April 1, 2018– August 31, 2018 (5 months)
2. Application Deadline: **October 31 2017**
3. Admission notification: December, 2017
4. Program Features:
 - Designed for undergraduate students both in Humanities and Science
 - Courses in English (Japanese language ability is not required)
 - Admission and tuition fee waiver
 - Being eligible to apply for the Japan Student Service Organization (JASSO) scholarship if students participate in HUSTEP
5. Important Details:
 - Applications received after the deadline will not be accepted.
 - Non-native English speakers must have a score of at least **TOEFL iBT 79 or IELTS 6.5**.
 - Due to the capacity of the program, there is a screening process to select the participants. Not all students who apply will be accepted.
 - Only a limited number of students can be nominated for the JASSO scholarship.
